**What:** Owyhee Dam Ride **When:** Sunday May 4, 2025 **Where:** Home Depot - 2808 E State St, Eagle, ID 83616 **Description:** Meet at 10am. KSU at 10:30am. Lead Road Captain David Kesner (Dr Dave) This will be the 15th annual ride to the Gordon Gulch day-use area on Lake Owyhee. Besides the great ride, the main purpose is to hopefully see the lake full and spilling over the Glory Hole. With all the water we have been getting this year it is a good possibility. This ride will go into Oregon so you will need a helmet. You can also bring a lunch to have at the park when we get there or stop at a restaurant on the way back. It will be approximately 70 miles one way. The first 45 miles are on easy two-lane country roads. The next 23 miles are on a narrow two-lane with much of it having no center marker. The last three miles are steep, narrow, winding, with no guard rails. There may also be a lot of RV traffic with boats, trailers, and motorhomes. Our route will start at the Home Depot in Eagle and travel down Highway 44 turning right on Old Highway 30. We will turn left on Oasis and continue where it turns into Market Road. This will take us to Highway 26 and into the town of Parma where we will make our only stop at the Valley Country Store. You will need to put on helmets here as we will be crossing into Oregon. Continuing on through town we will turn left on Highway 18 (Roswell Blvd.) through the town of Roswell (aliens may or may not be seen) where we will then turn right on Highway 452 and cross the Snake River into Oregon. We turn right and pick up Highway 201 here and go through the town of Adrian turning left on Overstreet and finally turn left onto Owyhee Lake Road. This section is the most picturesque riding along the Owyhee River through Red Rock Canyon. When we arrive at the bottom of the dam the next three miles or so will be the most challenging. Please space yourself out enough to give the rider in front of you room to maneuver the tight corners at a speed they feel safe. At the top of the dam, we will ride by the Glory Hole, which can be seen from the road. As you will see there is not much in the way of parking, so if you want to stop and look or take pictures I would encourage you to do so in small groups on the way back. Once at the park the ride will end and ride tickets given out. Most people choose to bring a lunch and eat at the picnic tables. Others may choose to head back and stop at a restaurant in one of the many towns on the way back. For those that want you may follow me back a different route to enjoy more of the farmlands.
